Commemorative Stamps

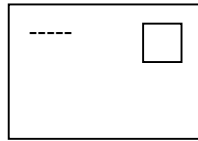
Save all cancelled stamps.

Place stamps on envelope in the upper right hand corner, allowing inch space on each edge.

** Stamps need not be trimmed or removed from the envelopes. IF trimming from envelopes, leave at least inch around stamp. Sorting into categories or weighting is not necessary. **DO NOT SOAK OFF!** Damaged stamps are those that are torn or the perforations have been

destroyed. If in doubt, send them to the stamp chairman to be assessed.
