Leader: Healer of our every woe, hope of every living thing, hear our prayers for those who are heavy-laden with physical, mental, emotional, or spiritual ills, especially those we name now in our hearts . . . Ease their pain; restore their hope and joy in you. God, in your mercy,

Group: Hear our prayer.

Leader: God of all who bear witness to the Gospel, we give thanks for the ministry of the LWML – the Lutheran Women in Mission, especially those who serve in this zone and community on behalf of the whole church. We give thanks for all their ministries locally and globally, both today and throughout the generations.
