



Banner designs to represent the LWML Texas District at the LWML Convention in Lexington, Kentucky are due Wednesday February 3, 2021. The banner procession at the LWML convention is a special highlight of the event.

Designs based on the convention theme, "Running the Race...Looking to Jesus" are submitted to President Frances Molitor and must be:

- ❖ On an 8.5" x 11" sheet of paper (include your name on the back of the sheet)
- ❖ In color
- ❖ With fabric swatches attached (heavy fabric or bulky items are discouraged)
- ❖ Contain the words **Texas District** (your choice of colors and size of letters) on the front side of the banner
- ❖ Include the approximate cost of construction

The design cannot use the convention logo. Heavy fabric or bulky items are discouraged, for mailing and carrying reasons. It will be rolled when mailed. The finished banner size is to be 3' x 5'. Added fringe may be longer. Specifications for the banner will be sent to the person whose design is selected.

The convention theme is based on *Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God* (Hebrews 12:1-2). The LWML Texas District Executive Committee will select one design at its February meeting and will notify the designer of the winning entry. The entrant whose design is chosen will be responsible for the construction of the banner, including dowel and cord. The LWML Texas District will reimburse expenses of construction.
