Our Goals

A primary focus of the campaign is that each woman of the LCMS is the Heart of LWML. Christ is in the heart of each woman as she engages in mission education, mission inspiration, mission service, and mission support. Each woman of the LCMS is invited to embrace her role as a Lutheran Woman in Mission.



The endowment logo explanation:

- The cross and implied heart symbolize the act of giving that proceeds from our hearts as a response to what God has done for us in Christ (2 Corinthians 9:7-8).
 - The words “Saving Today to Bless Tomorrow” convey our desire to endow future generations to accomplish God’s mission.
 - The LWML Texas District logo is incorporated as a reminder of our common mission: “As Lutheran Women in Mission, we joyfully proclaim Christ, support missions, and equip women to honor God by serving others.”

Endowments

The **Mission Goal Endowment** (EN334) provides funds for the mission goal of LWML Texas District. The mission goal includes mission grants and expenses of the district to accomplish its mission.

The **Mission Inreach Endowment** (EN165) provides funds for spiritual enrichment, member development and leadership training opportunities for members of the LWML Texas District.

The **Scholarship Endowment** (EN057) provides scholarships for Texas women attending an LCMS university who will be going into full-time church work fields.

The LWML Texas District endowment funds are administered by Legacy Deo, a charitable foundation affiliated with the Texas District LCMS. All funds contributed are invested. Each year LWML Texas District receives distributions of interest generated by these investments. This interest is directed to the specific purpose of each fund. As with all endowments, a larger principal means a greater income is available to fulfill the purposes of the endowments
