#### Registration

The 42nd Biennial Convention of the LWML Texas District will be held at the Hyatt Regency Houston West, 13210 Katy Freeway, Houston, Texas, on June 16-18, 2022.

Registration opens on March 1. For the discounted fee, registrations must be submitted or postmarked by May 1. Online registration is available at *lwmltxdist.org/lwml-texas-district-conventions* with payment by credit card through June 1. The registration form is available on the website, and is to be completed, printed and mailed to the registrar with payment (check payable to LWML Texas District or credit card information).

American Express cards will not be accepted by LWML Texas District for registration or at the convention, including the LWML store. Registration check-in at the Hyatt Regency will be open on Thursday from 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Friday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Please contact Registrar Roberta Heiner at registrar@lwmltxdist. org with questions.

### **Convention Agenda**

The convention will open on Thursday, June 16, with a Divine Service with Communion at 7:30 p.m. in the Texas Ballroom at the Hyatt Regency. The first business meeting will begin with singing at 8:15 a.m. on Friday. There will be business meetings on Friday afternoon and evening, and Saturday morning, which will include Keynote Speaker Christina Hergenrader, a Mites in Action speaker, Bible studies, song leaders Theron and Jessica Jenkins, and an entertaining Interrupter. The convention will conclude at noon on Saturday.

#### **Hotel Information**

The Hyatt Regency Houston West is now accepting reservations. The group rate for all blocked rooms is \$134 plus tax. The standard deluxe guestroom is good for one to four persons per room. We ask for reservations to be made before 5 p.m. on May 25. For online hotel reservations, use the direct link at <code>lwmltxdist.org/lwml-texas-district-conventions</code>. Reservations can also be made by calling the Hyatt at 281-558-8338; ask for the Lutheran Women's Missionary block. If you need assistance or a roommate, please contact Housing Coordinator Kathy Proske at <code>katproske@gmail.com</code>. If you would like an extended stay, the hotel will honor the rate for three nights before and after the convention based on availability.

#### **Travel**

Guests flying to Houston have a choice of two large airports. George Bush Intercontinental Airport (IAH) is in north Houston. Houston Hobby (HOU) is south off I-45. Both airports are 30-40 miles from the hotel.

Currently the Hyatt is not offering complimentary shuttle service and that is not expected to change. Be prepared to use Uber, Lyft, airport shuttles or rental cars. Both airports do offer shuttle service. For those traveling by vehicle, there is complimentary self-parking at the hotel. The parking garage and additional uncovered parking lot are located behind the hotel and are accessible from the I-10 Frontage Road or Park Row.

#### Meals

All meals are secured with registration only. On Friday and Saturday mornings a full breakfast buffet is available for \$25. The buffet consists of sliced fruit, chef's selection hot breakfast entree, assorted breakfast bread (muffins and danish), juice, coffee, decaf coffee and hot tea. The Friday box lunch will be available for \$20 and will consist of chef's choice for assorted sandwiches, chips, cookies, sodas and water. All listed prices include gratuity. Vegetarian, vegan and gluten free meals are available but must be noted on the registration form and preordered. Meal orders will not be accepted after June 1.

Friday's pastors lunch is available for \$25 and will be at Pappy's Café, 12313 Katy Freeway, Houston. All clergy attending are invited and encouraged to attend. There will be a choice of one of two entrees. If needed, transportation can be arranged by contacting Anita Long, Transportation Committee Chairman, at *allcri1976@yahoo.com*.

The Hyatt Regency does have a restaurant (limited seating) in the hotel. There are no restaurants within walking distance of the hotel but there are numerous choices within a short, easy driving distance. A two-hour dinner break is offered Friday night, which should allow you time to leave the hotel for dinner.
