Proposed amendments to LWML Bylaws

There are just three amendment changes proposed for the voting assembly's consideration at the LWML Texas District Convention, to be held June 16-18 in Houston.

Proposed Amendment #1 is to update guidelines for electronic voting.

Amendment #2 is to reflect changes made for lodging reimbursement for our pastoral counselors.

Amendment #3 is a change in the number of Teller Committee members should electronic voting be used in lieu of paper ballots.
