Camp Lone Star's Pines Campus in Tomball has a new mobile climbing wall in which three children at a time can climb. The wall was purchased through a 2020 Mission Grant from the LWML Texas District.

The plan was to use the wall at Urban Base Camp, Camp Lone Star's new outreach day camp program. COVID concerns squelched Urban Base Camp this past year. However, the wall was put to good use as a church group used the Pines facility each Wednesday during the summer for a day camp. Plans are being made to resume Urban Base Camp next year with the climbing wall as a major attraction.

The mission of Camp Lone Star is to "transform lives through adventurous, Christ-centered experiences by planting seeds of faith, cultivating Christian leaders, and growing the Kingdom of God." The climbing wall is not only fun and adventurous, but will help children learn to trust others and Jesus.

The wall can also be moved to different locations.
