Think of a time when you have been asked to reflect on who you are. Reflect on the answers that came to you. Perhaps you find yourself thinking of a time when you were parenting your children or spoiling your grandchildren. You saw the joy and the hope in their eyes as they placed their trust in you.

Having someone else place their trust and hope in you can be a real joy but it can also be a daunting task. Do you find yourself asking such questions as, "Who am I Lord that you have tasked me with caring for this next person?"

Look up Hebrews 2:5-6. What does it mean that God is mindful of us?

Or perhaps you find yourself thanking and praising the Lord for such blessings.

Look up Psalm 8:1. How does the Psalmist praise the Lord?

The Lord sets His glory above the Heavens. Yet, He is mindful of who we are: mindful that He would dare to lay down His life for us (Romans 5:8); mindful that He would give us His righteousness (Romans 3: 21-22); mindful that He would provide all things for us (Matthew 6:11).

We are reminded that He would continue to teach us the way to go and the way to live (2 Timothy 3:16-17). The scriptures remind us that our story is His story. It can be hard at times to give. Our sinfulness wants to look out for number one instead of the next person. Or perhaps we feel as though we have to rather than want to.

That is perhaps the next greatest blessing that God gives to us. With Jesus' story flowing through us the good news of the Gospel motivates us to want to give a witness for Christ and to be a blessing to those around us. We do not give from our wallets but from our Hearts!

We give freely of our time, we use our talents to point others to Christ, and we gladly tithe of the many treasures that God gives to us. With the Holy Spirit living within each of us we are led to trust God to provide.
