



**Rev. Dr. Jon Braunersreuther** serves as President of the Texas District of The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod (LCMS), elected to his first term at the district’s 63rd regular convention in June 2025. His ministry includes service as associate pastor at Zion, Brighton, Colorado (1989–1992), pastor at Prince of Peace, Amarillo, Texas (1992–1996), Mission and Ministry Facilitator for the Texas District (1996–2001), and Senior Assistant to the President of the LCMS (2001–2010). Prior to his election, he directed districtwide strategy as Mission Strategist for the Texas District.

Dr. Braunersreuther earned his Master of Divinity from Concordia Seminary, St. Louis in 1989, and his Doctor of Ministry from Regent University in 2019, where he was named “Outstanding Graduate.” He and his beautiful wife, Rachel, are blessed with two children, Andy (Ada) and Erin (Rev. Alex Lahue), and three grandchildren.

As president, he has emphasized a vision for a Gospel movement across Texas, encouraging the planting of new congregations and the development of new servant-leaders. Looking toward the district’s 125th anniversary in 2031, the prayer is that the Texas District will help send 500 new servant-leaders to reach 500 new communities with the Good News of Jesus.
