Registration

Convention Highlights

The convention opens on Thursday, June 13, with a Divine Service with Communion at 7:30 p.m. in the Corpus Christi Ballroom of the Omni Corpus Christi Hotel. Friday's session will begin at 8:15 a.m. The final session will be held Saturday morning with the convention concluding at 12:00 p.m. The sessions will include our keynote speaker, LWML Past President Debbie Larson along with two Mites in Action speakers. Travel

Guests flying into Corpus Christi International Airport and staying at the Omni need to call 361-887-1600 with personal flight information after hotel reservations have been made to schedule for free shuttle service to the Omni Hotel. Pick up is outside the baggage claim. If you plan to drive, you can self-park in the Omni garage for our special rate of \$5 per day with in and out privileges. Valet parking is available at the prevailing rate. The entrance to the garage is located on North Water Street. There is an entrance to the lobby from the garage. The Omni Water Street Lot will have complimentary selfparking.

Meals

All meals are secured with registration only. On Friday and Saturday mornings a full breakfast buffet is available at a cost of \$20. The buffet consists of sliced fresh fruit, hot breakfast entrée, assorted muffins and Danish, juice, coffee (regular and decaf), and hot tea. A boxed lunch will be available Thursday and Friday for \$15 and includes choice of a ham, turkey, or roast beef sandwich, chips, cookie, and a soda.
