Enrichment Sessions

Within Reach, led by Debbie Larson:

Teen Program

We are excited to invite teen girls (ages 12–17) to the convention for a fun-filled and servant-minded experience planned for just them! Teens will get to know one another with fun, crafts, and games along with being in God's Word with Bible studies, participate in on-site service projects, enjoy time in the pool, and will discover what the LWML is with activities geared toward their age groups and interests. The teen program will begin at 10:00 a.m. Thursday, June 13. Teens will pay a special registration rate of \$100 (or \$120 if submitted after May 7, 2024) which includes a T-shirt, snacks, Friday and Saturday breakfast, Thursday lunch, and Friday dinner. Teens should purchase Friday's boxed lunch option when registering and bring money for any purchase they plan to make at the LWML store.

Zone YWR Program

The Zone YWR program will begin at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, June 13, and conclude at the end of the convention on Saturday at noon. There will be opportunities for service, Bible study, fellowship, and training. Each ZYWR will sit with her zone president and delegation during the convention on Friday and Saturday. ZYWR's need to register for the convention and order the Friday boxed lunch.

Young Women Lunch (ages 18-40) and former Zone YWR's

On Friday at noon, all potential, current, and former young woman representatives are encouraged to order the Friday boxed lunch and bring it to the Bayview room to enjoy sharing ideas, experiences, and fellowship.

Pastors Lunch

The Pastors Lunch on Friday will be served off-site at Trinity Our Savior Lutheran Church, 808 Louisiana Avenue, for a cost of \$20 per person (Hoegemeyer's BBQ brisket, potato salad, green beans, iced tea, and peach cobbler). All clergy attending the convention are invited and encouraged to attend, and transportation will be provided if needed.

Meals

All meals are secured with registration only. On Friday and Saturday mornings a full breakfast buffet is available at a cost of \$20. The buffet consists of sliced fresh fruit, hot breakfast entrée, assorted muffins and Danish, juice, coffee (regular and decaf), and hot tea. A boxed lunch will be available Thursday and Friday for \$15 and includes choice of a ham, turkey, or roast beef sandwich, chips, cookie, and a soda. Vegetarian meals (grilled veggie sandwich) and gluten-free meals (turkey on gluten-free bread) are available but **must** be noted on the registration form and preordered. No meal orders will be accepted after May 31, 2024.

Gratuity is included in the price of all meals.
