## God's Promises

As many around Texas still beg God through prayer for sustaining rains, we know God still hears our prayers. He has made us promises. He promises to never leave us (Matthew 28:20). He promises He will care for us and give us what we need (Luke 12:30). He is always faithful (1 Corinthians 1:9). Mark 11:24 reminds us He hears our prayers.

We are reminded of His promise to never flood the earth again when we observe rainbows. Seeing a double rainbow is quite special. It can remind us of His complete and abundant love. An often, over-looked promise is *When I thought, "My foot slips," your steadfast love, O Lord, held me up. When the cares of my heart are many, your consolations cheer my soul* (Psalms 94:18–19). He promises to console us when we are burdened. He promises to carry those burdens, too (1 Peter 5:7).

God has promised us many things, and unlike flawed humanity, He always keeps them. He doesn't forget them. He doesn't take them back. He doesn't decide we are no longer deserving. His love for us is unconditional and unending.
