Any LWML Texas District member, group, or zone may submit a mission grant proposal for consideration by the Mission Grant Committee. The organizations and recipients being considered for an LWML Texas District mission grant must be spon-

sored by one of the above listed people who acts as the official submitter of the mission grant proposal.

The deadline for finishing the submission process is firm with **November 1, 2023**. The mission grant proposal can be submitted electronically, but hard copies must be received by the November 1, 2023 deadline.

It is highly recommended for organizations to communicate with the Vice President of Gospel Outreach by **October 1, 2023** at *gospeloutreach@lwmltxdist.org* to let her know of your intentions.
