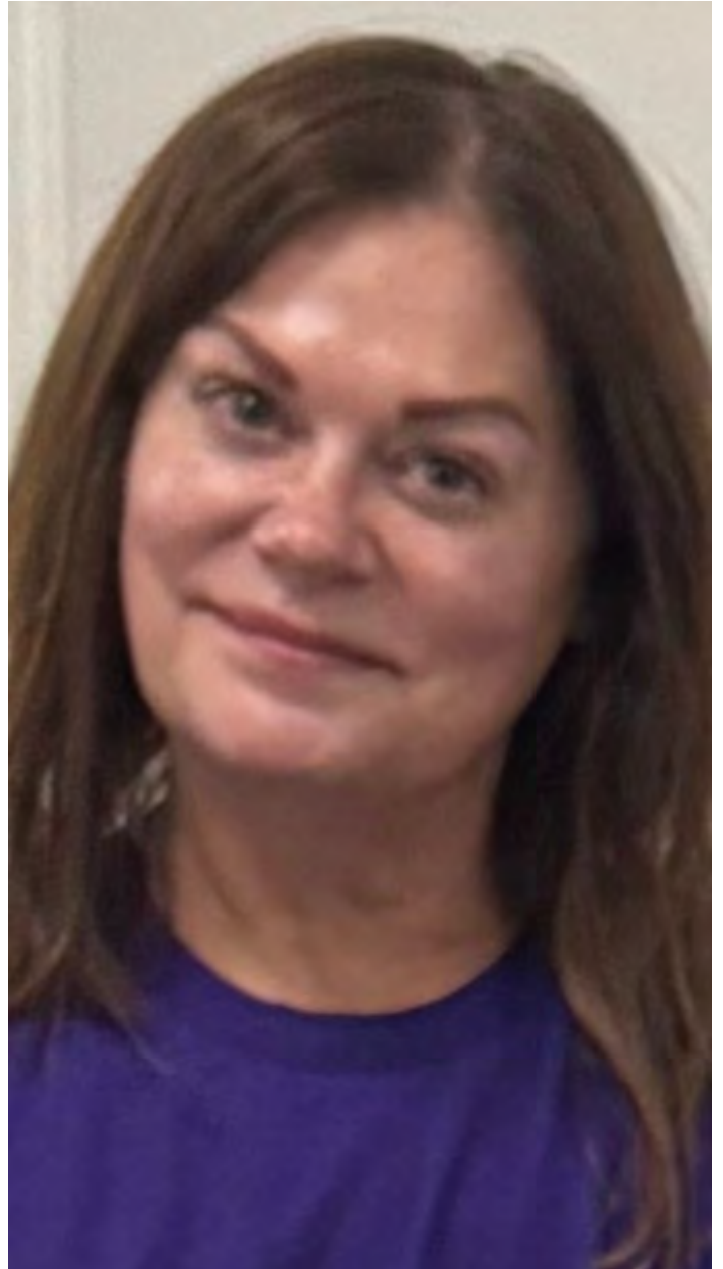
MONICA KAMINSKI

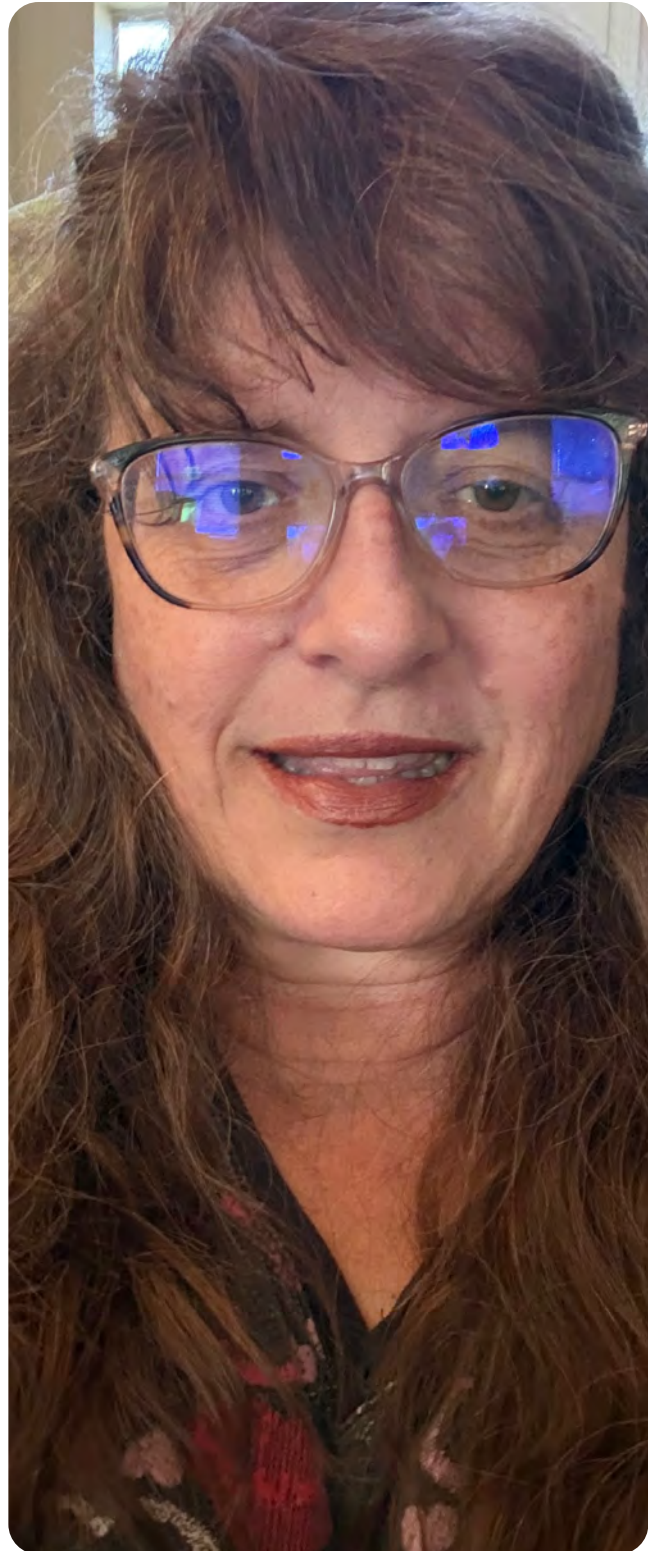
