

Ideas for Increasing Awareness of LWML **(STARTING WITH THE VERY YOUNG!)**

Girl Scouts – This group needs service projects. Encourage societies to include them in various projects.

Confirmation Students – Have a prayer partner exchange (beginning with first class and ending on Confirmation Sunday). Give some “Jeans Gems”. Provide snacks for a study break during the confirmation meetings or provide a breakfast or a luncheon for the Saturday before Confirmation Sunday.

High School Students – Provide snacks during the Sunday School hour. Talk about “Can Do” projects the LWML supports; give out Mite Boxes, Bible bookmarks and LWML candies.

College Students – Provide “Care Packages” filled with snack foods for study breaks. Provide Bible bookmarks, devotionals and words of prayer. These can be made up as a project night at a monthly meeting.

Brides – Send a congratulations card with a wrapped mustard seed devotional or a “Marriage Matters” devotion booklet as a small gift.

New Mommies – Send an honorarium card to her with the donation in the child’s name. An invitation to an LWML activity or meeting should be included with a note that a free nursery is available.

Career Women – Send an invitational letter with a “Noontime Nibbles” devotion in it.

New Members – If there is a new members class, go in and hand deliver candy card invitations. Follow up by sending an invitational letter with LWML information in it (showing mission projects, explaining Mites, etc.). Include a Mite Box and a personal message.

New Christians – Send an invitational letter. Include more information regarding mission; why it’s necessary and how the LWML works. Include Bible bookmarks, Mite Box, current mission projects (local, district, and national) and devotion.
